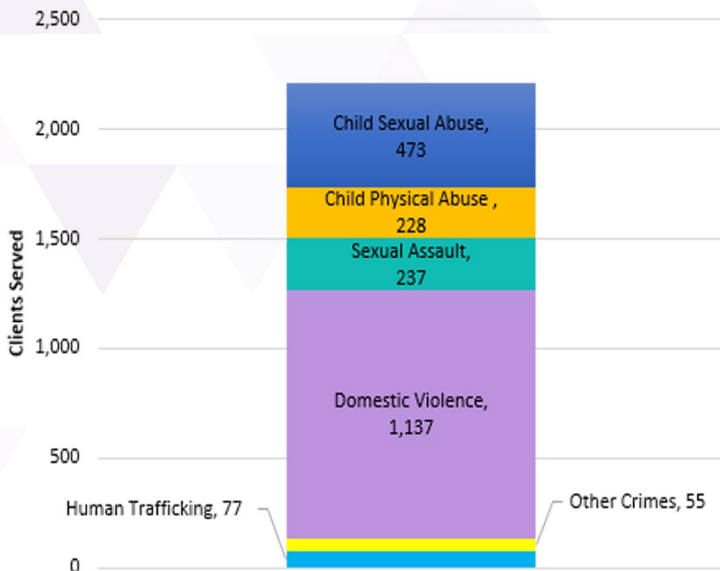

Types of Victimization

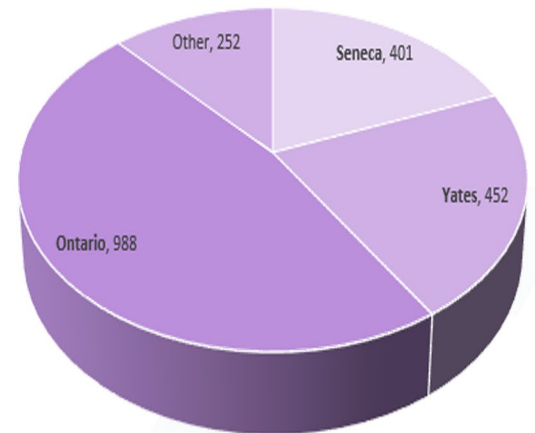


Safe housing continues to be high need in our area with a 68.85% increase over 2020.

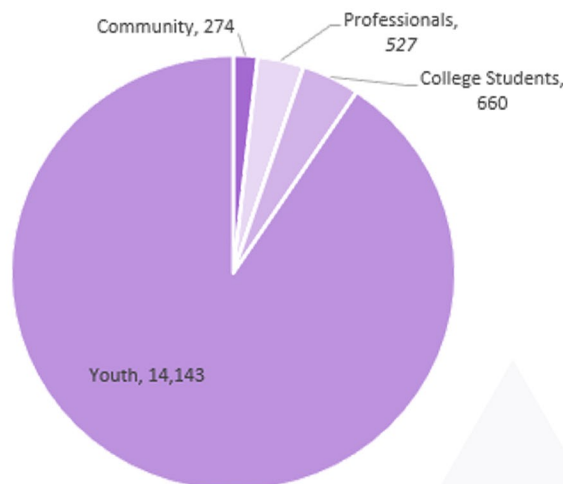


We are developing an emergency shelter and transitional housing program to respond to this community need.
